Misc. Coming Events: The library and the Current are bringing back the Story Walk. The theme is Climate Change. People will be asked to write about their favorite place in Stowe that aren't there anymore. The book club is being held at The Current. They are reading Jodi Picoult's, *Mad Honey*. The librarians are considering an all-ages book group hopefully reading something by a Vermont author. After hours at the library will begin this month with events like creative writing classes, passive game nights for teens and tweens or 20s and 30s, etc.
