**Special Event Application – Heady Trotter** 

**Summary**: Tiburon Endurance Sports is seeking approval to host their seventh annual Heady Trotter road race on Sunday, October 20, 2024 from 10:00am – 11:00am, followed by music at the Alchemist Brewery. The route is a loop that starts and ends at the Alchemist, utilizing Stoweflake Meadows Road, Cape Cod Road, Weeks Hill Road, and the Rec Path. Map of the route is attached. Green Mountain Adaptive Sports is their official charity and will receive a portion of the proceeds. Anticipated race attendance is listed at 1,999, with attendance at the Alchemist event following it anticipated to be significantly less.

Satellite parking will be at Top Notch events field. The event contracts a school bus shuttle to take attendees to the Alchemist.




