LCPC Brownfields Committee Appointment

Summary: Lamoille County Regional Planning Commission (LCPC) Brownfields Committee oversees LCPC's Brownfields Program. The committee reviews and prioritizes sites for the Region's brownfields assessment program, and provides oversight for the program, consultants, and project completion. Planning and Zoning Director Sarah McShane has served as Stowe's representative for the past few years, but with staff workload, it would be prudent to appoint Assistant Town Manager Will Fricke to the position. In his previous position with ICMA, Will ran the educational programming for the National Brownfields Training Conference, and is very familiar with brownfield redevelopment and grant funding.
