Village Green Picnic Tables Donation

Summary: The Avocado Pit (112 Main Street) has requested to donate two picnic tables to the Town of Stowe for the Village Green on the corner of Park Street and Main Street. These two new picnic tables would not replace the two picnic tables currently on the Village Green, which are weathered but in serviceable condition. There would be four total picnic tables on the Village Green, which is the number that staff recommend capping the number of picnic tables at due to the need to maintain the green and accommodate other uses.

Recommendation: Accept the donation of picnic tables with the understanding that the Town has the right to relocate or remove them should it become necessary, that the Town does not have an obligation to replace them after their natural life, and that there will be no additional picnic tables placed on the Village Green unless otherwise agreed to by the Selectboard.
